In water works are not anticipated to occur during this period and as such no navigational tug assist will be available/provided.

Two stern anchors and buoys have been disconnected from the marine derrick but remain in place. Buoy locations as follows:

Anchor – North Buoy – 49 12' 34.20"N / 122 53' 28.24"W
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A revised NAVWARN will be issued if in-water works on Pier 4 + 5 Scour Protection intend to proceed.










