





Geotechnical Investigative Work Upstream of the Existing Pattullo Bridge

August 10, 2021

Between August 16 and 27, Fraser Crossing Partners, the contractor who will build the new bridge, plans to conduct geotechnical investigations near the northern shoreline just upstream of the existing Pattullo Bridge.

While this work is underway, crews will drill 5 to 10 boreholes from a floating barge to gather subsurface soil information.

These boreholes will be advanced using a sonic drill at depths of 2-15 metres underwater.

Traffic

No impacts to vehicle traffic are anticipated. Marine users will be notified in advance of this work commencing.

Nearby residents may see crews on site and may hear noise associated with the sonic drill. Noise levels from this work are expected to be low.

There may be some impact on the marine navigation in the area and marine users will be notified in advance of the start of works.
