

Bridge foundation construction in Surrey

UPDATED: January 6, 2022

Bridge foundation work in Surrey started in summer 2021.

Over the coming months, work will begin on the bridge foundations and bridge approach structures located near Highway 17 (shown in the graphic). This work will continue through 2022.

When traffic pattern changes and/or lane closures are required, additional notice will be provided in advance.

Bridge foundation work involves:

- Intermittent pile driving
- Placement of reinforced steel and concrete

Timing

Ongoing through 2022.



Hours of Work

Intermittent pile driving will occur:

Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

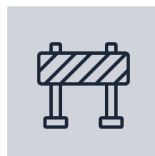
Welding and other ancillary work on site will occur at night and on Sundays.

No pile driving activities will take place on holidays.



Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses and residents will hear some noise and may feel some vibration from the intermittent pile driving. All general construction activities and other non-pile driving activities (welding, concrete work, etc.) will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Temporary lane closures and detours will be required.
