





One-hour extension of daily Columbia Street loop-ramp closure

May 27, 2022

On select evenings between May 28 and June 5, FCP will be conducting utility investigation work within the Columbia Street loop-ramp. To accommodate this work, FCP will extend the daily 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. closure by one hour, such that the loop-ramp will be closed to traffic until 7 p.m.

During the loop-ramp closure from 3 p.m. to 7p.m., drivers travelling westbound on Columbia Street will be detoured to use the Royal Avenue on-ramp. Trucks are asked to follow detour signs and use Braid Street. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists using the BC Parkway and Central Valley Greenway to access the Pattullo Bridge.

Select evenings between May 28 and June 5.



Hours of Work

3 p.m. to 7 p.m.



Traffic

Detours will direct traffic for accessing the Pattullo Bridge. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be wellsigned.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear some noise from the utility investigation work. Drivers may experience temporary delays resulting from the detour. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
