





Pattullo Bridge: Overnight Northbound Lane Closures

June 17, 2022

Starting in late June, crews will begin work to rehabilitate the Royal Avenue overpass as part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project. The first stage of work will be completed from the Bridge Connector roadway under the overpass, and will require up to four overnight closures of the Pattullo Bridge in the northbound direction, as well as a closure of the Bridge Connector in New Westminster.


Pattullo Bridge users going to New Westminster are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the northbound lane closures. Northbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected customers should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time.

TransLink's single lane closure for southbound traffic on the Pattullo Bridge will remain in effect; however, one southbound lane will remain open. Motorists coming from McBride Boulevard will be detoured to use the Columbia Street on-ramp. The Royal Avenue on-ramp will remain open.

Three to four overnight closures of the northbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge. Detours will be required.
