






Traffic pattern changes and construction on Bridge Connector New Westminster

June 21, 2022

Starting late June, crews will begin work to rehabilitate the Royal Avenue overpass as part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project. The first stage of work will be completed from the Bridge Connector roadway under the overpass. Lanes will be shifted in phases to create the necessary work space adjacent to the overpass walls. The existing number of travel lanes on the Bridge Connector will generally be maintained; however, a few overnight full closures of the Bridge Connector and on the Pattullo Bridge in the northbound direction will be required during this work (more information on those closures is available here). While this work is underway, noise from construction equipment is expected.

Additional overpass rehabilitation work is expected to begin on Royal Avenue in August. Notification for that work will be provided in advance.



What to Expect



Timing

Lane shifts on the Bridge Connector will be in place from June to November 2022.



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
Other ancillary work, which is not expected to be noisy, will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Traffic

Lane shifts and occasional single lane closures. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience temporary delays resulting from occasional single lane closures.

Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with work activities.
