





Continuous concrete pour for on-land New Westminster bridge foundation

July 7, 2022

On Saturday, July 9, Fraser Crossing Partners conduct a continuous 12-hour concrete pour to complete the pile cap for the onland bridge foundation in New Westminster that is north of Columbia Street. Starting early in the morning, during the coolest part of the day, and working continuously ensures the structural integrity of this foundation.

Nearby residents may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment starting at 6:00 a.m. while work is underway. Concrete trucks will access the work area north of Columbia Street via McBride Boulevard.

Once the concrete pour is complete and the concrete has cured, crews will begin work on the formwork and the abutment wall for this foundation.

Timing

Saturday, July 9



Hours of Work

12 hour continuous pour starting at 6:00 a.m. Crews will begin set-up at 5:00 a.m., but this is not anticipated to be noisy.



Traffic

Traffic control personnel will be on McBride Boulevard to assist concrete trucks accessing the work area.



Impacts/Interruptions

Residents and businesses may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway. Access to the sidewalk on the west side of McBride Boulevard will be maintained and traffic control personnel will assist pedestrians when required.
