



Concrete pour for bridge foundation in Surrey – July 15

July 13, 2022

On July 15, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting a continuous 16-hour concrete pour to complete the pile cap for the on-land bridge foundation that is closest to the Surrey shoreline. Concrete trucks will be accessing the foundation throughout the duration of the pour from the main work yard in Surrey. Starting early in the morning, during the coolest part of the day, and working continuously ensures the structural integrity of this foundation. Residents and businesses may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway.

Once the concrete pour is complete and the concrete has cured, crews will begin work on the formwork and concrete pours for the pier columns.

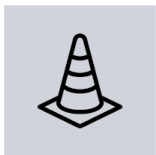
Timing

Starting the morning of July 15 and continuing for approximately 16 hours



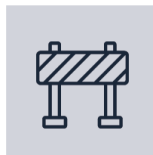
Hours of Work
