

Notification of test piling work – Surrey Late July – Early August, 2018

As part of our ongoing work to replace the existing and aging Pattullo Bridge, the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project will complete a “test pile” in Surrey at the location shown below. This work will take place over a three-week period in late July and early August. The purpose of the test pile is to provide geotechnical information for the design and construction of the new bridge.

During the three-week test pile period, there will be intermittent pile driving activity taking place Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

While these test-piling activities are underway, there will be crews and heavy machinery at the test pile location in Surrey. This work will generate some noise for the surrounding area in Surrey, and lower-level noise will be audible along the foreshore and in some residential and business areas in New Westminster.

No traffic impacts are expected.
