

Weekend Lane Closures in New Westminster – Pattullo Bridge North Approach

July 6, 2020

As part of planning for the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project, Fraser Crossing Partners (FCP) will be inspecting the Royal Avenue overpass the weekend of July 11 and 12. The detailed condition assessment will help inform the construction plans for this structure.

Crews will be using lifts to examine the abutments of the existing structure from the bridge approach in New Westminster. On Saturday, July 11, there will be a northbound lane closure of the bridge approach underneath the Royal Avenue overpass. On Sunday, July 12, equipment will be set up in the southbound shoulder, and lane closures of the bridge approach in both directions underneath the Royal Avenue overpass will be implemented.

Hours of Work

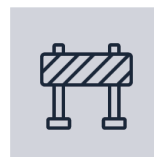
On Saturday, July 11 work will be completed between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m.

On Sunday, July 12 work will be completed between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m.



Traffic

All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be onsite to direct traffic as required. Local residents will notice a lift and equipment trucks that are required as part of this inspection.



Impacts/Interruptions

Crews will be using a lift to do a detailed inspection of the existing structure and abutments. Some drilling will be required, but minimal noise is anticipated as part of this work. Lane closures will be in effect when crews are working.
