

UPDATED: Bridge Foundation Investigation Work in Surrey

Early September to October 2020

Fraser Crossing Partners, the contractor who will build the new bridge, will be doing foundation investigation work in Surrey in the area of the new bridge alignment. This investigation work, a test pile, will provide additional information about the soil conditions for the piers that are required for the new bridge.

Crews will be setting up in the area north of Musqueam Drive and east of the existing bridge in Surrey. Equipment will include cranes, a pile driving hammer, and other heavy machinery that will be used to install large steel piles in sections. Nearby businesses and residents will hear noise and might feel some vibration associated with the piling work.

What to Expect



Timing

Work is anticipated to start in early September 2020 and take six to eight weeks to complete.



Hours of Work

Piling will occur Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Welding will occur Monday to Friday between 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.



Traffic

Traffic will not be impacted by this work.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses and residents will hear noise and might feel some vibration associated with the piling work. Piling will occur intermittently for the first half of these works.
