



# Nighttime Investigative Work on Highway 17 and Bridge Road

April 8, 2021

Between April 12-15, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting nighttime investigative work at the Highway 17-Old Yale Road intersection, and on Bridge Road. This work will be completed in stages and will require temporary lane closures on Highway 17 between Tannery Road and Old Yale Road, as well as closures of Bridge Road, between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

The following road or lane closures will be required; however, not all will be required at the same time:

- **Overnight eastbound and westbound single lane closures on Highway 17.** During this time, the left turn onto Old Yale Road will be closed, and traffic will be detoured to Tannery Road.
- **An overnight eastbound right lane closure on Highway 17.** During this time, drivers travelling north on Old Yale Road will not be able to access Highway 17, and traffic will be detoured to Tannery Road.
- **An overnight closure of Bridge Road.** During this time, drivers requiring access to Bridge Road will be detoured to 130 Street.

A technique that emits minimal noise will be used to penetrate and examine soil throughout the duration of this work. Crews will also use pressurized water to investigate underground utilities on Bridge Road.

All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be on-site when needed.

### Hours of Work

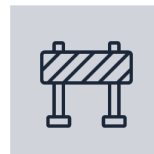
7:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m.

### Traffic

Intermittent lane closures and detours will be required during this work. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



### Impacts/Interruptions

While sonic drilling emits minimal noise, there will be some engine noises that may be heard if in close proximity. Equipment used as part of the utility investigation work on Bridge Road may also be heard if in the area.
