



In-River Bridge Foundation Construction

May 28, 2021

Fraser Crossing Partners will resume work on the in-river bridge foundations this summer. This work is anticipated to start in late June or early July, subject to river conditions and in accordance with Fisheries and Oceans Canada requirements for minimizing impact to fish and fish habitat. A crane and barges will be used to achieve this work, as well as a temporary in-river access platform for marine construction on the Surrey side. Once foundation work on the main tower is complete, crews will begin formwork and concrete pours for the tower, which will be approximately 170 metres high.

Bridge foundation work in the river will involve:

- Intermittent pile driving
- Placement of reinforced steel and concrete

On-land foundation work will also be required for the new bridge, and advance notice will be provided before this work begins.

Weekly updates for marine users regarding in-river construction activities will be posted on pattullobridgereplacement.ca.

What to Expect



Timing

In-river bridge foundation work will start in summer 2021 and continue through the year.



Hours of Work

Intermittent pile driving will occur:
Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. and
Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
Welding and other ancillary work on site will occur at night and on Sundays.

No pile driving activities will take place on Sundays or holidays.



Traffic

No vehicle traffic impacts are expected.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses and residents will hear some noise from the intermittent pile driving. As much as possible, a shroud will be used during pile driving to reduce noise. All general construction activities and other non-pile driving activities (welding, concrete work, etc.) will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

About the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project

The new four-lane, toll-free bridge will provide important improvements for people who are driving, cycling or walking, as well as communities on either side of the bridge. The new bridge will be located just upstream and northeast of the existing bridge and is scheduled to open in 2024. Once the new bridge is open, the existing bridge will be removed.

The Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project is being delivered and overseen by Transportation Investment Corporation and the project workforce provided by B.C. Infrastructure Benefits. Fraser Crossing Partners is the contractor selected to design and build the new bridge, and the Province of B.C. will own and maintain the new bridge when construction is complete.



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
