



Utility investigation work in New Westminster

July 6, 2021

Fraser Crossing Partners, the contractor who will build the Pattullo Bridge replacement, will be conducting utility investigation work in New Westminster on Royal Avenue and Columbia Street between July 12 and July 22, 2021.

Sections of pavement will be removed and pressurized water will be used to locate and inspect underground utilities. This is required prior to the start of construction in the area.

While this work is underway, the following traffic pattern changes will take place:

- Columbia Street: traffic will be reduced to a single lane in the eastbound direction west of McBride Boulevard (near the Pattullo Bridge).
- Royal Avenue: traffic will be reduced to a single lane in the eastbound direction between Dufferin Street and McBride Boulevard. The on-ramp to the Pattullo Bridge will not be impacted.

Royal Avenue: July 19-22, 2021



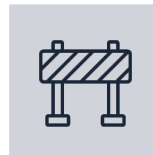
Hours of Work

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.

Nearby businesses and residents may hear noise due to pavement removal, hydrovacating activities and idling vehicles.
