

Work area set-up adjacent to Highway 17 and Tannery Road

August 23, 2021

Beginning the week of August 23, Fraser Crossing Partners will start utilizing the open area adjacent to Highway 17 eastbound off-ramp to Tannery Road in Surrey. This work area will be fenced and used to store materials and equipment. Trailers will also be moved on site.

Existing dirt within the work area will also be excavated and transported to other Project areas when required.

No traffic impacts are anticipated from these activities; however, when required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists.

Timing

Crews will mobilize on site during the week of August 23.

The work area will remain in use for the duration of the Project.

Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Ancillary work on site may occur at night and on Sundays.



Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents will see crews on site and may hear some noise associated with on site vehicles, equipment and the use of excavators. No traffic impacts are anticipated.
