



Construction on Highway 17 in Surrey

Updated: January 6, 2022

Site preparation work is underway in advance of construction of the bridge foundation located within Highway 17 (shown in the graphic below).

Fraser Crossing Partners is relocating utilities, realigning barriers and creating a work zone and access points within the middle of Highway 17. Some temporary daytime lane closures, as well as a short nighttime full closure to transport equipment, will be required on Highway 17 for both eastbound and westbound traffic. More specific information regarding lane closures and detours will be provided via road signage and to traffic media. Drivers should watch for signage which will have information regarding date and time of these traffic pattern changes.

Once the site preparation work is complete, construction of the bridge foundation at this location will begin. General construction activities will take place 24/7 while intermittent pile driving will only take place between 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Nightly lane closures on Highway 17 for both directions will be required.

All traffic pattern changes will be well signed and traffic control personnel will be onsite.

Timing

Ongoing through summer 2022.



Hours of Work

Intermittent pile driving will occur:

For the bridge foundation within Highway 17:
Monday to Saturday from 7:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.

For other bridge foundations in Surrey:
Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Welding and other ancillary work on site will occur at night and on Sundays.



Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses and residents will hear some noise and may feel some vibration from intermittent pile driving. All general construction activities and other non-pile driving activities (crane setup, welding, concrete work, etc.) will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Temporary lane closures and detours will be required.
