



Geotechnical investigation work in New Westminster

January 6, 2022

Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting geotechnical investigation work at two locations in New Westminster starting this week and continuing the weeks of January 10 and January 17 (if required).

While this work is underway, crews will use a sonic drill to gather subsurface soil information and locate utilities. Intermittent lane closures will be required. Below are the areas where the geotechnical investigative work is scheduled to take place:

- Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and the Columbia Street on-ramp
- Royal Avenue between Peele Street and Windsor Street

Timing

Starting January 7 and continuing for approximately two weeks.



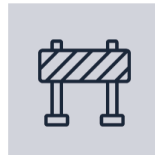
Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.



Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from a hydrovac (required in advance of drilling) or from the sonic drill. Every effort will be made to minimize noise levels while work is underway. Intermittent lane closures will be required.
