

Traffic pattern changes on 112 Avenue for bridge foundation and roadway construction

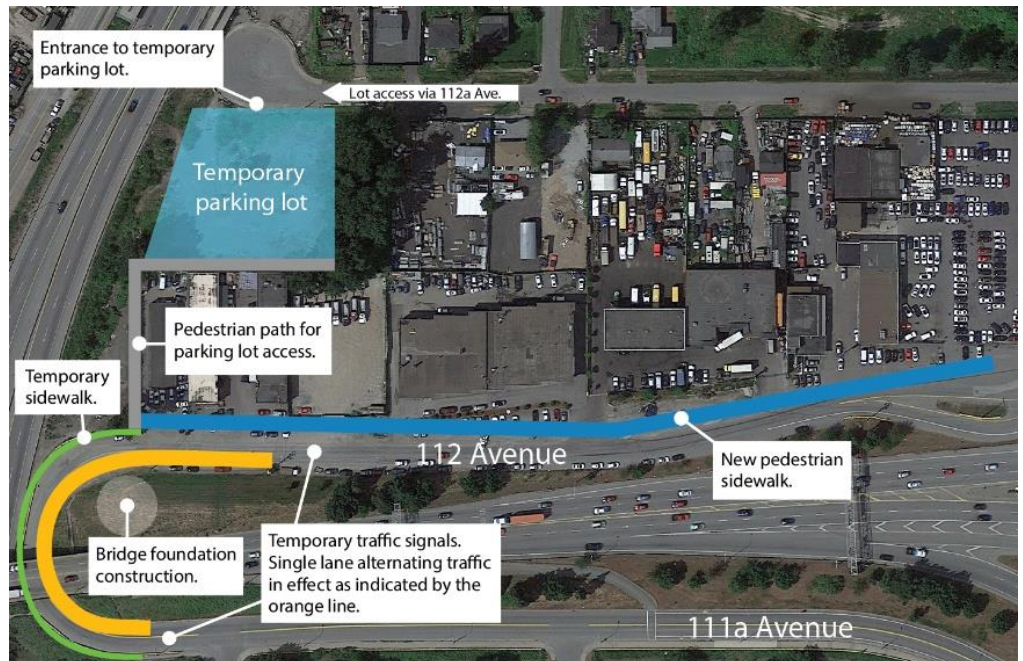
Starting next week, FCP will implement traffic pattern changes on 112 Avenue between Highway 17 and 124 Street. These changes are required for ongoing bridge foundation and roadway work in this area.

FCP will install two temporary traffic signals – one on 112 Avenue and a second on 111a Avenue (as shown on the diagram below). Single lane alternating traffic will be in effect for the section that goes under the existing bridge, and a temporary sidewalk will be implemented (as shown in green).

The temporary traffic signals and sidewalk will be in place for approximately one year to ensure the safety of pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers while work is underway.

Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary, and access to the business driveways along 112 Avenue will be maintained at all times.

Construction of the new pedestrian sidewalk on the east side of 112 Avenue is expected to begin in late January. While work is underway on 112 Avenue, all business customers should use the temporary parking lot off of 112a Avenue as on-street parking near the work area will be restricted.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting in January 2022 and continuing into 2023.



Hours of Work

Work in the area will take place Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

General construction activities will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Traffic

Temporary single lane alternating traffic will be implemented for the section 112 Avenue and 111a Avenue that goes under the existing bridge. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists when required. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses will hear some noise from crews and equipment while work is underway. Drivers may experience short temporary delays resulting from the traffic signals.

Communication with the businesses along 112 Avenue is ongoing, and additional notification will be provided in advance of specific construction activities and traffic impacts.
