



Concrete pour for the main tower foundation – April 5

April 4, 2022

Beginning April 5, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting a continuous 36-hour concrete pour to complete the pile cap for the main tower foundation. Concrete trucks will be accessing the foundation throughout the duration of the pour using the temporary access platform from the Surrey work yard and barges on the river. It is important for the pour to be continuous to ensure structural integrity. Residents and businesses may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway.

Once the concrete pour is complete and the concrete has cured, crews will begin work on the formwork and concrete pours for the tower.

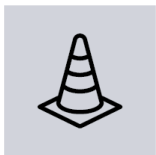
Timing

Starting the morning of April 5 and continuing for approximately 36 hours



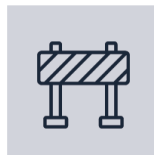
Hours of Work
