



Highway 17 eastbound lane closure

October 3, 2022

The Highway 17 eastbound fast lane, just east of the Pattullo Bridge, will be temporarily closed starting at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, October 4 and continuing until 11 a.m. on Wednesday, October 5. This extended closure is for crews to pour the pier cap for the bridge foundation that is in the centre median of the highway. This lane closure is required so that equipment and crews can safely access and perform work at this location. The eastbound slow lane will remain open at all times.

Access for emergency responders will be maintained at all times, and all traffic pattern changes will be well signed. Traffic control personnel will be on site when required and drivers are asked to follow signage and obey traffic control personnel.

Starting on Tuesday, October 4 and continuing until the morning of Wednesday, October 5



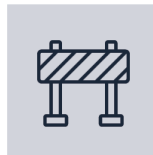
Hours of Work
