



Highway 17 westbound lane closure

October 20, 2022

On Saturday, October 22 (between 7am and midnight), westbound Highway 17 between the Pattullo Bridge and Tannery Road will be temporarily reduced to one westbound lane for road paving. The lane closure is weather dependent. The eastbound lanes on Highway 17 will not be affected by this work.

Access for emergency responders will be maintained at all times, and all traffic pattern changes will be well signed. Traffic control personnel will be on site when required and drivers are asked to follow signage and obey traffic control personnel.

What to Expect



Timing

Saturday, October 22

Please note, paving work is weather dependent. If the weather is excessively wet/rainy on October 22, work will be rescheduled for when conditions are dry.



Hours of Work

Between 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. midnight



Traffic

When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary lane closure of the Highway 17 westbound slow lane just west of the Pattullo Bridge to Tannery Road.

Noise from heavy machinery may be heard when in close proximity.
