





# Bridge foundation construction in Surrey – northbound slow lane closures and evening work on Pattullo Bridge approach


Construction of the bridge foundations and approach structures in Surrey is underway and will continue through 2022.

Fraser Crossing Partners has completed pile driving for the bridge foundation adjacent to 112 Avenue (shown on the blue line below), and will now resume pile driving activities for the new Highway 17 off-ramp foundation (shown on the green line below). A northbound slow-lane closure will be required on the Pattullo Bridge approach during pile driving activities due to the proximity of the foundation to the existing bridge and road.

To minimize traffic impacts, the northbound slow-lane closure will take place on some weekends and weeknights starting November 16 and continuing for approximately one month, during active pile driving work. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed, traffic control personnel will be onsite to assist when necessary, and traffic signs will be in place at key locations to enable drivers to plan alternate routes in advance. The lane closure will be in place:

- Weeknights between 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- Saturdays between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
- Sundays between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

# What to Expect



#### **Timing**

Starting November 16 and continuing for approximately one month.



## **Hours of Work**

Intermittent pile driving will occur:

- Monday to Friday from 7:00 pm 10:00 pm
- Saturdays from 7:00 am 10:00 pm
- Sundays from 10:00 am 4:00 pm

Welding and other ancillary work onsite will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week. No pile driving activities will take place on holidays.



#### Traffic

Northbound slow-lane closures on the Pattullo Bridge approach:

Weeknights from 7:00 pm - 10:00 pm

Saturdays from 7:00 am - 10:00 pm

Sundays from 9:00 am - 6:00 pm

Road signage will be in place and traffic control personnel will be onsite.



## Impacts/Interruptions

Businesses and residents will hear noise and may feel vibration associated with the intermittent pile driving for on-land bridge foundations.
