



Utility work at Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street

November 30, 2022

Starting the week of December 5, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting some utility work on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street for approximately two weeks. Traffic on Agnes Street will be shifted to create a work area for crews to perform the underground utility work which will include saw cutting, some excavation and hydrovaccing.

One lane in each direction on Agnes Street will remain open and access to Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be maintained at all times. While this work is underway, there will be temporary parking restrictions on both sides of Agnes Street.

All traffic pattern changes and parking restrictions will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required.

Timing

Starting the week of December 5, 2022 and continuing for approximately two weeks.



Hours of Work

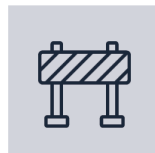
- Monday to Friday from 7 am – 8 pm.
- Saturday from 9 am – 6 pm.

Lane shift and temporary parking restrictions will be in effect 24/7



Traffic

Traffic lanes on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be shifted to create work space. Travel in both directions will be maintained. Traffic control personnel will be on-site when required to assist with crews accessing the work area.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, hydrovaccing and other machinery during the day. Crews will also be in the area to perform the work, and temporary parking restrictions will be in effect. We appreciate your patience and understanding while this work is underway.
