



Nighttime lane closures of Highway 17

January 6, 2023

Starting Sunday, January 8 and continuing for approximately one week, Fraser Crossing Partners will implement nightly lane closures of Highway 17 in both directions between the existing Pattullo Bridge and Tannery Road to conduct utility work. Lane closures are being implemented at night to minimize disruption to traffic.

This work will be completed in stages and will require the following traffic management in both directions of Highway 17, between the existing bridge and Tannery Road, between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.:

Highway 17 Eastbound and Westbound:

- Highway 17 will be reduced to one travel lane in both the eastbound and westbound directions. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times.
- The shoulder bike lanes on Highway 17 will be maintained during the construction work.

Old Yale Road:

- When Highway 17 lane closures are in place, there will be turning restrictions at the intersection of Old Yale Road / Highway 17. Drivers will be detoured to use Tannery Road, as needed.

Access to Bridge Road north of Highway 17 will be maintained while this work is underway.

Crews will use excavators and hydrvacacs to complete this utility relocation work. Access for emergency responders will be maintained at all times, and all traffic pattern changes will be well signed. Traffic control personnel will be on-site when required and drivers will need to follow traffic signage and obey traffic control personnel.

Timing

Starting Sunday, January 8 and continuing nightly for approximately one week.



Hours of Work

Nighttime lane closures of Highway 17 in both directions between: 7:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.

Turning restrictions to and from Old Yale Road, as needed: 7:00 p.m. – 5:00 a.m.



Traffic

Temporary lane closures and turning restrictions will be required, and detours will be implemented. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Noise from the use of heavy machinery will be heard when in close proximity to the work area.
