





Bridge foundation construction in Surrey – Sunday pile driving for Highway 17 off-ramp foundation

January 9, 2022

Fraser Crossing Partners has completed pile driving for the main bridge alignment and will begin pile driving for the new Highway 17 off-ramp foundations and bridge approach structures in January 2023. Due to the proximity of one of the off-ramp foundations (shown within the green line below) to active railway tracks, intermittent pile driving will be required for two to three Sundays at this location.

Pile driving at this location will take place during the following times:

- Monday to Saturday between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m.
- Three Sundays between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Welding and other ancillary work will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week. No pile driving activities will take place on holidays. Once the pile driving activities are complete, crews will begin formwork and concrete pours.

Hours of Work

Intermittent pile driving will occur:

- Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Sundays from 10:00 am 4:00 pm

Welding and other ancillary work will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week. No pile driving activities will take place on holidays.

No traffic impacts are expected as part of this work. However, road signage will be in place and traffic control personal will be on site if required.
