



McBride Boulevard lane closure and nighttime work

February 23, 2023

On Thursday, February 23 and Friday, February 24, Fraser Crossing Partners (FCP) will require a single southbound lane closure on McBride Boulevard between Royal Avenue and Columbia Street to complete underground utility and road widening work. One southbound lane will be maintained at all times.

To complete this work, hydrovaccing, sawcutting, jackhammering, and excavation activities will be required. FCP will complete as much noisy work during daytime hours as possible; however, some noisy work will be required until 10 p.m.

While this work is underway, the sidewalk on the west side of McBride Boulevard between Royal Avenue and Columbia Street will be closed. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the east side of McBride Boulevard. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist as required and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.

Timing

Thursday, February 23 and Friday, February 24
Saturday may be required to complete this work.



Hours of Work

- Thursday from 7 p.m. – 5 a.m.
- Friday from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. – 5 a.m.
- Saturday from 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. (if required)

Noisy work will take place during daytime hours and may be required until 10 p.m. Other non-noisy work may occur 24 hours a day.



Traffic

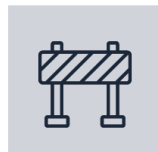
Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic as required. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.

The lane closure will be in place:

Thursday from 7 p.m. – 5 a.m.

Friday from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. – 5 a.m.

Saturday between 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. (if required)



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from hydrovaccing and saw cutting activities, as well as heavy equipment including an excavator and jackhammer. The sidewalk on the west side of McBride Boulevard will be closed and pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the east side of McBride Boulevard while this work is underway.
