





Tree removal on Dufferin Street

March 2, 2023

Fraser Crossing Partners will remove some trees in the right-of-way adjacent to the Royal Avenue on-ramp to create the required space for construction of new multi-use pathways and the improved Royal Avenue on-ramp. Tree removal work will be done in stages, beginning March 6, 2023.

Trees removed as part of Project work will be replaced at a minimum ratio of 2:1. The Project team will work closely with municipalities and First Nations on the replacement of trees and the enhancement of sites within the Project area over the duration of the Project. This will include planting new trees and shrubs in the area.
