





Bridge foundation construction in Surrey



Fraser Crossing Partners has completed pile installation for the main bridge foundations, and work is continuing to progress for the new Highway 17 off-ramp foundations and bridge approach structures (shown in the graphic). This work will continue into Spring 2023.

When traffic pattern changes and/or lane closures are required, additional notice will be provided in advance.

Bridge foundation work for the Highway 17 off-ramp involves:

- Intermittent pile driving
- Placement of reinforced steel and concrete

Hours of Work

Intermittent pile driving will occur: Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Welding and other ancillary work on site will occur at night and on Sundays.

Under certain circumstances, pile driving activities may be required on Sundays or holidays with the appropriate permissions. Additional notification would be provided in advance.



Traffic

Temporary closures of Bridge Road will be required while this work is underway. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses and residents will hear some noise and may feel some vibration from the intermittent pile driving. All general construction activities and other non-pile driving activities (welding, concrete work, etc.) will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Temporary lane closures and detours will be required.
