





Bridge foundation construction in Surrey – weekend pile driving for Highway 17 off-ramp foundation


March 22, 2023

Pile driving for the new Highway 17 off-ramp foundations and bridge approach structures is ongoing. Due to the proximity of one of the off-ramp foundations (shown within the green line below) to active railway tracks, intermittent pile driving will take place during some upcoming weekends when there are no active trains.

Pile driving at this location will take place during the following times:

- Saturday, March 25, April 1, April 8 (if required), and April 14 (if required) between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m.
- Sunday, March 26, April 2, and April 9 (if required) between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Friday, April 7 between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. (if required)

Welding and other ancillary work will occur 24 hours a day while this work is underway. Once the pile driving activities are complete, crews will begin formwork and concrete pours.

Timing

Saturdays – March 25, April 1, April 8 (if required), and April 14 (if required)

Sundays – March 26, April 2, and April 9 (if required)

Friday – April 7 (if required)



Hours of Work

Saturdays: Intermittent pile driving will occur between 7 a.m. – 10 p.m.

Friday, April 7 and Sundays: Intermittent pile driving will occur between 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Welding and other ancillary work will occur 24 hours a day while work on this foundation is undereway.



Traffic

Bridge Road between Old Yale Road and Musqueam Drive will be closed. Local business access only. While the closure is in effect, drivers will need to use 130 Street in order to access Industrial Road.

Road signage will be in place and traffic control personal will be on site if required.
