

Overnight closure of Highway 17 westbound between Old Yale Road and Tannery Road

March 29, 2023

On Thursday, March 30 between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m., Fraser Crossing Partners (FCP) will require an overnight closure of Highway 17 westbound between Old Yale Road and Tannery Road.

This overnight closure is required for crews to remove an overhead guide-sign on the shoulder of Highway 17.

When the overnight Highway 17 westbound closure is in effect:

- Drivers travelling westbound on Highway 17 will be detoured to the Tannery Road on-ramp via 120 Street.
- Drivers on municipal streets on either the north or south side of the highway will be able to access Highway 17 westbound by using the Tannery Road on-ramp.



Additional overnight closures will likely be required to complete roadwork activities in advance of the Highway 17 realignment work currently scheduled for mid-April. Notifications will be provided in advance.

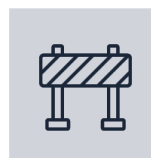
Hours of Work
