





Temporary Highway 17 realignment between Tannery Road and Pattullo Bridge and permanent removal of left-turn onto Old Yale Road southbound

April 11, 2023

In mid-April, Highway 17 between Tannery Road and the Pattullo Bridge will be temporarily realigned as part of ongoing construction for the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project. Two lanes in each direction will be maintained at all times during the day; however, occasional single-lane nighttime closures on Highway 17 will be required when traffic volumes are low.

Once the realignment is implemented, the left-turn from Highway 17 westbound onto Old Yale Road southbound will be permanently removed. Westbound drivers exiting Highway 17 can use Bridgeview Drive or Tannery Road.

The removal of the left-turn from Highway 17 westbound onto Old Yale Road southbound is part of the staging for constructing a new overpass which will replace the existing traffic signal at Highway 17 and Old Yale Road, improving traffic flow along Highway 17. More information will be provided in advance of overpass construction.

What to Expect



Timing

The temporary realignment of Highway 17 will be implemented in mid-April for approximately 12 months. The removal of the left-turn lane from Highway 17 westbound onto Old Yale Road southbound will be permanent.



Hours of Work

The temporary realignment of Highway 17 will remain in effect 24/7.



Traffic

Occasional single-lane nighttime closures on Highway 17 will be required. The left-turn from westbound Highway 17 onto Old Yale Road southbound will be permanently removed. Drivers exiting Highway 17 should use Bridgeview Drive or Tannery Road. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience temporary delays resulting from occasional lane closures, detours, and having to adjust to the new traffic movement. Noise from heavy machinery may be heard when in close proximity. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
