



Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project

2023 construction activities on Highway 17

There will be a number of activities on Highway 17 in Surrey as part of ongoing construction for the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project. Throughout 2023, crews will be constructing the foundations for the off-ramp from the new bridge to Highway 17 westbound, installing the girders for the new bridge over Highway 17, and constructing a new Highway 17 overpass at Old Yale Road. To minimize impacts to drivers, most of this work will be done at night and lane closures and detour routes will be implemented.

1. Ongoing foundation work for the new Highway 17 off-ramp – Spring 2023

Foundation work for the new Highway 17 off-ramp is ongoing. This includes pile installation and construction of the concrete columns. Some closures of Bridge Road will be required while this work is underway.

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2. Highway 17 realignment and permanent removal of left turn onto Old Yale Road – Spring 2023

In spring 2023, Highway 17 between Tannery Road and the Pattullo Bridge will be temporarily realigned. Two lanes in each direction will be maintained as this section of roadway will be shifted slightly north as part of staged construction in this area. Once the realignment is implemented, the left turn from westbound Highway 17 onto southbound Old Yale Road will be permanently removed. Westbound drivers looking to exit Highway 17 will use Bridgeview Drive or Tannery Road.

3. Girder installation for the new bridge: overnight closures of Highway 17 – Late spring / early summer 2023

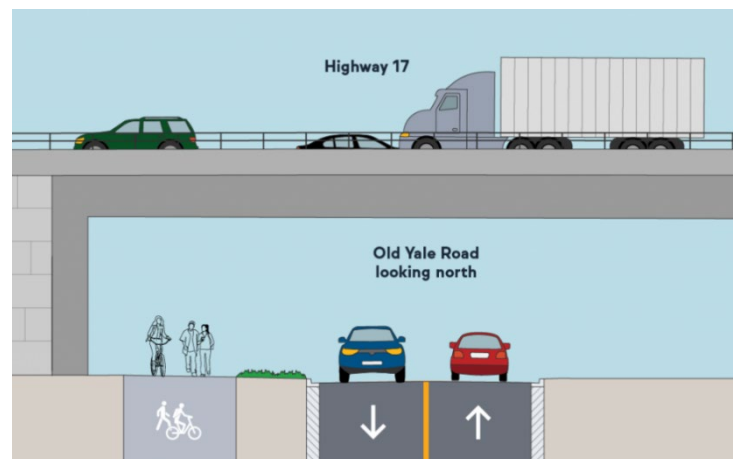
In late spring / early summer 2023, construction of the new bridge over Highway 17 will begin with crews lifting girders into place over the existing road. Highway 17 between Old Yale Road and Bridgeview Drive will be closed overnight in both directions for approximately three weeks when girder installation is underway. Some overnight closures of Musqueam Drive, Bridge Road, and 112 Avenue and 111a Avenue will also be required. Detour routes will be in effect while these closures are in place.

4. Construction of the Highway 17 / Old Yale Road overpass – Spring through fall 2023

In the final alignment, Highway 17 will be grade-separated over Old Yale Road, improving traffic flow on Highway 17. Bridge Road will be upgraded to a two-way road with a new multi-use path.

Step 1: In spring 2023, construction of the Old Yale Road overpass will begin. Occasional closures of Old Yale Road and turning restrictions to and from Highway 17 will be required.

Step 2: In fall 2023, drivers heading eastbound on Highway 17 will be moved onto the overpass, and will no longer be able to access or exit Highway 17 to or from Old Yale Road. Westbound traffic on Highway 17 will remain at-grade.

Step 3: In late 2023/early 2024, westbound traffic will be moved onto the completed Old Yale Road overpass. Once the overpass is complete, drivers will access or exit Highway 17 at Tannery Road. This is a permanent change.

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
