

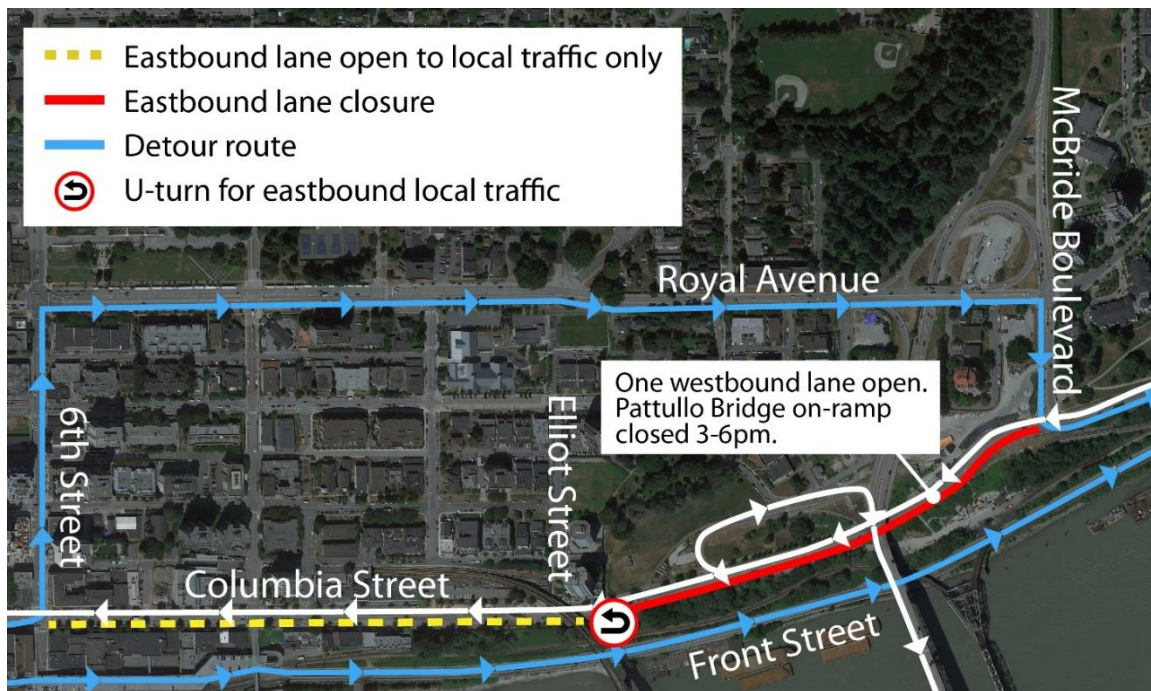
Columbia Street road closure between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street

April 4, 2023

Starting April 17, weekday and weekend traffic pattern changes will be implemented on Columbia Street for the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project to complete underground utility work. This work will take approximately five weeks.

Eastbound Closure of Columbia:

- **Location:** Eastbound closure of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street.
- **Time:** 24/7
- **Detour Route(s):** Royal Avenue via 6th Street, and Front Street
- **Other Important Information:**
 - One westbound lane will be open on weekdays between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m., including access to the Pattullo Bridge on-ramp. The on-ramp will continue to be closed between 3 p.m. – 6 p.m.
 - Columbia Street between 6th Street and Elliott Street will remain open to local traffic.
 - All access for local businesses on Columbia Street will be maintained.
 - Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times
 - The Central Valley Greenway will remain open for pedestrian and cyclist use.

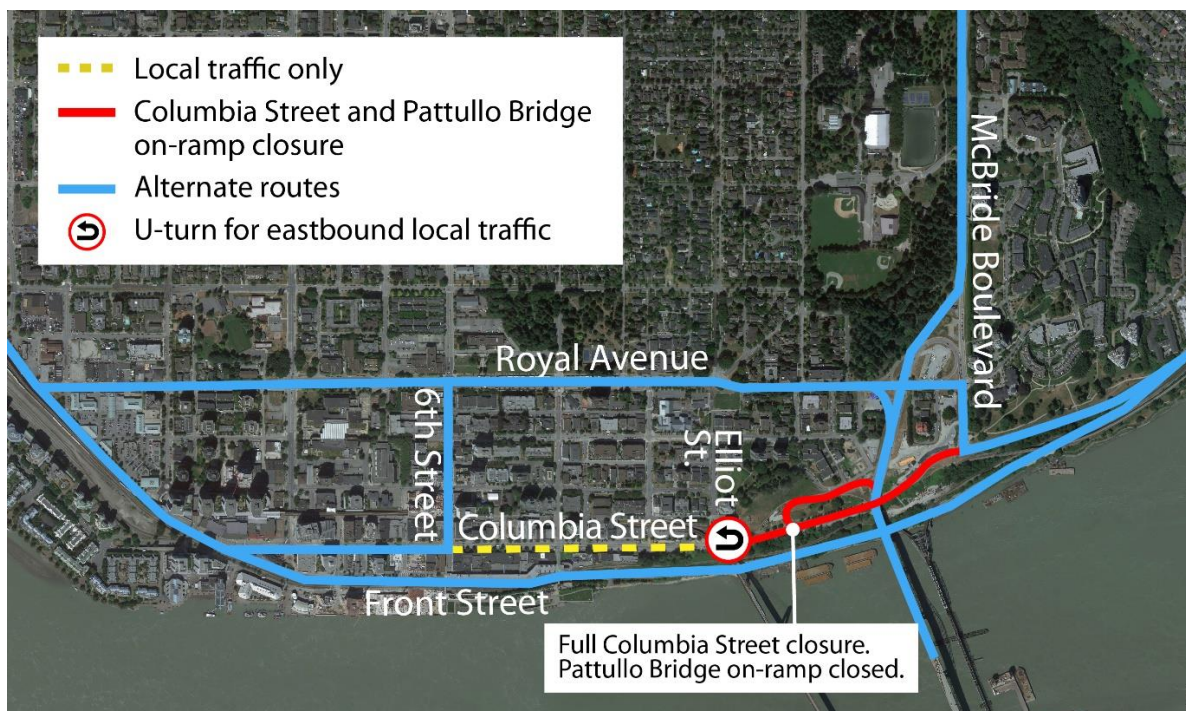

Full closure of Columbia on some weeknights (Monday to Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.)

Full closure of Columbia on some weekends (Saturday and Sunday)

- **Location:** full closures of Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street will be required.
- **Time:** Some nights Monday to Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
Some weekends (from Friday at 9:00 p.m. to Monday at 5:00 a.m.)
- **Detour Route(s):** Royal Avenue via 6th Street, and Front Street.
- **Other Important Information:**
 - Drivers will be notified in advance of weekend and weeknight full closures via pattullobridgereplacement.ca, road signage and traffic media advisories.
 - When the Columbia St. on-ramp to the Pattullo Bridge is closed, drivers (non-trucks) can access the bridge:
 - via westbound Braid Street, left on East 8th Avenue, and left onto McBride Boulevard
 - via westbound Front Street, and right onto Royal Avenue
 - Trucks will continue to use official truck routes (including observing applicable time restrictions) to access the Pattullo Bridge
 - Columbia Street between 6th Street and Elliott Street will remain open to local traffic.
 - All access for local businesses on Columbia Street will be maintained.
 - Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times
 - The Central Valley Greenway will remain open for pedestrian and cyclist use.

Timing

Starting April 17 for approximately five weeks.



Hours of Work

24/7 work. Work at night is not anticipated to be noisy.



Traffic

Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic as required. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed. Pedestrians and cyclists will not be impacted when this work is underway.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from heavy equipment including an excavator and jackhammer. Drivers may need to plan for additional travel time.
