





# Lane closures on Royal Avenue between McBride Boulevard and Dufferin Street


# June 20, 2023

Starting Thursday, June 22, FCP will complete the final stages of the Royal Avenue overpass rehabilitation work. Lane closures will be implemented on Royal Avenue between McBride Boulevard and Dufferin Street for crews to complete the approach slabs (the transition between the roadway pavement and the overpass structure).

The following traffic pattern changes will be implemented while this work is underway:

- Eastbound / westbound vehicles on Royal Avenue: one lane in each direction will be maintained.
- Northbound vehicles
  using the Bridge
  Connector: access for
  drivers coming from
  Surrey to New
  Westminster via the
  Bridge Connector off ramp will be maintained.
  Drivers travelling to Royal
  Avenue westbound will
  yield to through traffic.
- Royal Avenue off-ramp from McBride Boulevard
  - **southbound:** the left-turn restriction to Royal Avenue eastbound will remain in effect. Access to Royal Avenue westbound will be maintained.
- Right-in, right-out access to and from Leopold Place; occasional turning restrictions to and from Bushby Street.
- Pedestrian and cyclist access along Royal Avenue will be maintained.

A one-way only configuration may be required for one to two weekends in July. Advance notice will be provided once details are confirmed.

# What to Expect



#### Timing

Starting June 22, 2023 and continuing for approximately three months.

Note, paving is weather dependent. We will complete this work as quickly as weather permits.



#### **Hours of Work**

Lane closures will be in effect 24/7 during this work period.

Work activities will take place:

Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Some non-noisy work activities may take place at night.



### Traffic

Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



## Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from back-up beepers and heavy equipment required for paving during the hours of work.

Drivers may experience temporary delays on Royal Avenue. We appreciate your patience and understanding while this work is underway.
