



Continuous concrete pour for in-river foundation near New Westminster shoreline

June 23, 2023

Starting at 5 a.m. on Tuesday, June 27, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin setting up to perform a continuous 36-hour concrete pour to complete the pile cap for the in-river bridge foundation near the New Westminster shoreline. It is important for the pour to be continuous to ensure structural integrity.

Nearby residents may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway. Concrete trucks will access the foundation throughout the duration of the pour using the temporary access platform from the New Westminster shoreline south of Front Street.

Once the concrete pour is complete and the concrete has cured, crews will begin work on the pier columns.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting the morning of Tuesday, June 27 and continuing for approximately 36 hours.



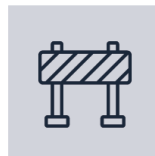
Hours of Work

36 hour continuous pour starting at 6:00 a.m. Crews will begin set-up at 5:00 a.m.



Traffic

Single-lane alternating traffic will be in effect on Front Street starting at 8 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27 and continuing until 5 a.m.



Impacts/Interruptions

Residents and businesses may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway. We appreciate your patience while we complete this work.

Intermittent stoppages will take place throughout the day. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist concrete trucks accessing the work area.
