



McBride Boulevard – utility relocation work

June 14, 2023

Starting in mid-June, the McBride Boulevard southbound slow lane between Royal Avenue and Columbia Street will be closed for approximately one month to complete utility work in this area. One southbound lane will be maintained at all times and all turning movements at the intersection of McBride Boulevard and Columbia Street will be permitted.

When this lane closure is in effect, the west sidewalk on McBride Boulevard for this section of roadway will also be closed. Pedestrians will temporarily need to use the east sidewalk while this work is underway.

Some saw-cutting and hydrovaccing activities will be required but will be undertaken during daytime hours.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting in early June and continuing for approximately one month.



Hours of Work

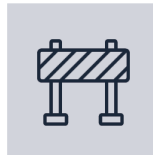
The majority of the work will be completed between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on weekdays and between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturdays. Some non-noisy work will take place at night and on Sundays.

The southbound lane closure will be in effect 24/7.



Traffic

Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic as required. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the east side of McBride Boulevard when this work is underway.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from the saw-cutting and hydrovaccing activities, as well as from heavy equipment including an excavator and jackhammer.

Drivers may need to plan for additional travel time. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
