





Multi-use path foundation construction in Surrey – Pattullo Bridge southbound slow lane closure and evening work

July 10, 2023

Starting Thursday, July 13, crews will begin intermittent pile driving for the new multi-use path foundation that is directly adjacent to the existing Pattullo Bridge.

A southbound slow-lane closure will be required on the Pattullo Bridge while pile driving activities are underway at this location due to its proximity to the existing bridge and road. To minimize traffic impacts, the southbound slow-lane closure will take place on some weeknights between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Intermittent pile driving will occur on these evenings between 8 p.m. and 10 p.m.

All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be onsite to assist when necessary.

What to Expect



Timing

Approximately 10 evenings of intermittent pile driving will be required over the course of one month, starting on July 13.



Hours of Work

Intermittent pile driving at this location will occur weeknight evenings from 8 p.m. – 10 p.m.

Welding and other ancillary work onsite will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Traffic

Southbound slow-lane closure on the Pattullo Bridge on weeknights from 8 p.m. – 5 a.m. when required. Road signage will be in place and traffic control personnel will be onsite.



Impacts/Interruptions

Businesses and residents will hear noise and may feel vibration associated with the intermittent pile driving.
