





Concrete pours for Royal Avenue sidewalk

July 24, 2023

Work on the Royal Avenue overpass is ongoing and the next stage will be to construct the sidewalk on the south side of the overpass.

Starting at 6:00 a.m. on both Tuesday, July 25 and Friday, July 28, Fraser Crossing Partners will be pouring concrete early in the morning, during the coolest part of the day, to ensure the structural integrity of the sidewalk and support structures.

Crews will begin set-up at approximately 5:00 a.m. Nearby residents may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment starting at 6:00 a.m. Every effort will be made to minimize noise from back-up beepers.

Concrete trucks will access the work area via Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist with access.

Hours of Work

Crews will begin set-up at 5:00 a.m., but this is not anticipated to be noisy.

The concrete pour will begin at 6 a.m.



Traffic

Traffic control personnel will be at the intersection of Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard to assist concrete trucks accessing the work area.



Impacts/Interruptions

Residents may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway. Access to the temporary pedestrian bridge on the south side of Royal Avenue will be maintained and traffic control personnel will assist pedestrians and cyclists when required.

We appreciate your patience and understanding while this work is underway.

Approximately four to six additional early morning concrete pours at the Royal Avenue overpass will be required, and advance notification will provided once dates are confirmed.
