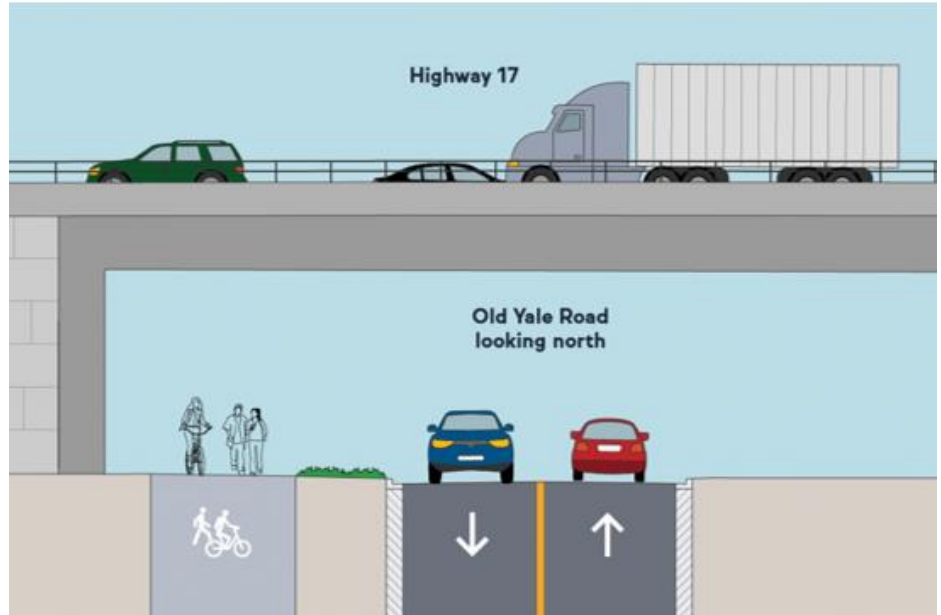
Highway 17 / Old Yale Road Overpass

Construction of the Highway 17/Old Yale Road Overpass

As part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project, Highway 17 will be grade-separated over Old Yale Road, improving traffic flow on Highway 17.

Overpass installation will be done in phases, with access to and from Highway 17 via Old Yale Road reduced then fully removed by the final phase of work.

Drivers looking to access Old Yale Road from Highway 17 will use Tannery Road starting in 2024.

2023-2024 Construction phases

Step 1: In spring 2023, construction of the Old Yale Road overpass began. Occasional closures of Old Yale Road and turning resections to and from Highway 17 were required.

Step 2: In fall 2023, crews will lift girders for the new overpass into place. Highway 17 between Old Yale Road and Bridgeview Drive will be closed overnight in both directions for approximately three weeks. Construction of the bridge deck will commence after girder installation is complete.

Step 3: In late 2023/ early 2024, eastbound traffic will be moved onto completed Old Yale Road overpass, and eastbound drivers will access or exit Highway 17 at Tannery Road or Bridgeview Drive. Construction of the westbound portion of the Old Yale Road overpass will then begin.
