



Underground drainage work on Dufferin Street

August 1, 2023

Starting Thursday, August 3, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting underground drainage work along the east side of Dufferin Street. This work will take approximately two and a half weeks to complete.

To complete this work, traffic lanes will be shifted to create space for crews to excavate underneath the existing roadway. Temporary no parking restrictions will be in place along the east side of Dufferin Street. Access to the sidewalk will be maintained.

All traffic pattern changes and parking restrictions will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting Thursday, August 3 and continuing for approximately two and a half weeks.



Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Saturday from 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Lane shift and temporary parking restrictions will be in effect 24/7. No work will be conducted over the BC Day long weekend.



Traffic

Traffic lanes on Dufferin Street will be shifted to create work space. Travel in both directions will be maintained. Traffic control personnel will be on-site when required to assist with crews accessing the work area.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, hydrovacating, and other machinery during the day. Temporary parking restrictions will be in effect. We appreciate your patience and understanding while this work is underway.
