



Concrete pours for ongoing Royal Avenue approach slab work

August 21, 2022

Starting at 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 22, Fraser Crossing Partners will be pouring concrete as part of the ongoing work on the Royal Avenue overpass. This early morning start, during the coolest part of the day, and then working continuously ensures the structural integrity of the approach slab (the transition between the roadway pavement and the overpass structure).

Crews will begin set-up at approximately 5:00 a.m. Nearby residents may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment starting at 6:00 a.m.

Concrete trucks will access the work area via Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist with access.

Hours of Work

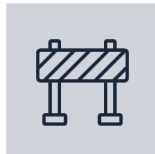
Crews will begin set-up at 5:00 a.m., but this is not anticipated to be noisy.

Traffic

Traffic control personnel will be at the intersection of Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard to assist concrete trucks accessing the work area.



Impacts/Interruptions

Residents may hear noise from concrete trucks and heavy equipment while work is underway. Access for pedestrians on the south side of the Royal Avenue overpass will be maintained and traffic control personnel will assist pedestrians and cyclists when required.
