





Pattullo Bridge: Overnight Northbound Lane Closures

September 1, 2023

Construction of the new bridge deck is underway in Surrey with crews lifting steel girders across Highway 17 just east of the existing Pattullo Bridge. On September 8 and 9, Fraser Crossing Partners will require two overnight closures of the Pattullo Bridge in the northbound direction due to the proximity of the girder installation equipment to the existing bridge. The closures are noted in the table below:

1	Friday, September 8	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Pattullo Bridge Northbound (towards New Westminster)	
2	Saturday, September 9	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Pattullo Bridge Northbound (towards New Westminster)	

Pattullo Bridge users going to New Westminster are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the northbound lane closures. Northbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected customers should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Emergency vehicle access, and access for pedestrians and cyclists, will be maintained.

TransLink's single lane closure for southbound traffic on the Pattullo Bridge will remain in effect; however, one southbound lane will remain open.


