





Investigative ground work in Brownsville Bar Park

October 17, 2023

Starting the week of October 30 (weather dependent), Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting investigative ground work within Brownsville Bar Park. This work will take approximately one week to complete.

While this work is underway, crews will use a small excavator fitted with an auger drill to drill approximately six boreholes to gather subsurface soil information. No vegetation removal will be required.

Pedestrian access to and within the park will be maintained at all times.

This work is required to inform plans for a temporary access road that will support the removal of the existing Pattullo Bridge once the new bridge is open. Additional investigative works will be required at a later date.



What to Expect

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Timing

Starting the week of October 30, 2023 and continuing for approximately one week.



Traffic

Nearby businesses, residents, and pedestrians may notice construction vehicles and equipment accessing Brownsville Bar Park via Old Yale Road. Traffic control personnel will be onsite to assist if necessary.

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Hours of Work

Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Some non-noisy work activities will take place at night.

Impacts/Interruptions

Within each investigative area, workers will be operating a small excavator fitted with an auger drill which will produce intermittent noise.
