





Rescheduled: Overnight full closure of the Pattullo Bridge

November 10, 2023

Starting at 8 p.m. on Wednesday, November 15 and continuing until 5 a.m. on Thursday, November 16, the Pattullo Bridge will be closed in both directions. This closure was originally scheduled for November 10 but was rescheduled due to poor weather conditions. This closure is required for Fraser Crossing Partners to update lane configurations on the bridge approaches in both New Westminster and Surrey to accommodate additional construction activities.

Pattullo Bridge users are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser during the closure.

Northbound and southbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected customers should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Emergency vehicle access, and access for pedestrians and cyclists, will be maintained.

This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if required. Please watch for updates on street signage and traffic message boards.
