



Temporary turning restrictions to and from Bushby Street

January 29, 2024

Starting Wednesday, January 31, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting underground utility work on Royal Avenue at Bushby Street. This work will take approximately three days to complete.

Due to the excavation required, access both in and out of Bushby Street will be restricted 24 hours a day. Local residents will be redirected to Leopold Place where access in and out will be maintained. Temporary no parking will also be in effect on the west side of Bushby Street. Pedestrian access on Royal Avenue will be maintained through the work zone.

Nearby residents may hear noise from the excavation activities while this work is underway.

Starting Wednesday, January 31 and continuing for approximately three days.



Hours of Work

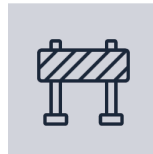
7 a.m. – 8 p.m.

The turning restrictions to and from Bushby Street, and the temporary no parking, will be in place 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Local traffic will be directed to Leopold Place during the restrictions in and out of Bushby Street. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear some noise from excavation activities. Temporary no parking will be in effect on the west side of Bushby Street. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
