





# Multi-use path construction along Royal Avenue and McBride Boulevard

## January 31, 2024

Starting Thursday, February 1, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin building the multi-use path (MUP) on Royal Avenue between Bushby Street and McBride Boulevard, and on the west side of McBride Boulevard between Royal Avenue and Columbia Street. The first stage of work will take approximately three weeks to complete.

While this work is underway, Royal Avenue eastbound and McBride Boulevard southbound will be reduced to one lane. Pedestrian access will be maintained around the work zones and traffic control personnel will be onsite to assist as needed.

A portion of the hedge on the south side of Royal Avenue at Leopold Place will need to be removed to provide space for new streetlights and utilities. Nearby residents may hear noise from the hedge removal and excavation activities as part of this work. Final landscaping features will be completed at a later date.

# What to Expect



### **Timing**

Starting Thursday, February 1 and continuing for approximately three weeks.



#### **Hours of Work**

- Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. − 8 p.m.
- Saturday from 9 a.m. 6 p.m.

Some non-noisy work activities will take place at night.



## **Traffic**

Royal Avenue eastbound and McBride Boulevard southbound will both be reduced to one lane. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



#### Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear some noise from excavation and hedge removal activities. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
