





Tree removal between Front Street and Columbia Street

February 20, 2024

Starting Friday, February 23, crews will be removing some trees and shrubs within the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project area between Front Street and Columbia Street as part of bridge deck construction activities. This will happen when the Front Street closure is in effect.

Trees removed as part of this Project work will be replaced at a minimum ratio of 2:1. The Project team will work closely with municipalities and First Nations on the replacement of trees and the enhancement of sites within the Project area over the duration of the Project. Starting Friday, February 23 and continuing for approximately two weeks.

Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Some weekend work will be required between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Front Street will be closed for bridge deck construction activities while tree removal is underway.

Nearby businesses and residents may hear noise from tree removal equipment.
