

Intermittent nighttime closures of Old Yale Road

February 29, 2024

Starting Monday, March 4, intermittent closures of Old Yale Road between Highway 17 and 120 Street will be required from 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. This section of Old Yale Road will remain open to local traffic only.

These nighttime closures are required while crews continue construction of the eastbound portion of the new Old Yale Road overpass and will continue intermittently for approximately four weeks. Drivers will be detoured to Tannery Road for access to Highway 17. While this work is underway, the Highway 17 eastbound slow lane will also be closed.

Access for emergency responders will be maintained and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed. Traffic control personnel will be on-site to assist pedestrians and vehicles when required.



What to Expect



Timing

Starting Monday, March 4 and continuing intermittently for approximately four weeks.



Hours of Work

7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Closures will not be required every night.



Traffic

Old Yale Road between Highway 17 and 120 Street will be open to local traffic only. The Highway 17 eastbound slow lane will be closed and turning restrictions between Highway 17 and Old Yale Road will be in place. Drivers will be detoured to Tannery Road for access to Highway 17. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.
