UPDATED: March 8, 2024

Underground utility work on Royal Avenue at Leopold Place has been underway since Wednesday, March 6. Fraser Crossing Partners will require approximately four additional days to complete this work, starting Monday, March 11.

Please be advised that while this work is underway, access in and out of Leopold Place will be temporarily reduced between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Local residents will be directed to use Bushby Street where access in and out will be maintained. Parking restrictions on Leopold Place closer to Royal Avenue will also be in effect. Pedestrian access on Royal Avenue will be maintained.

Nearby residents may hear noise from excavation activities related to the utility work. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.

Timing Continuing Monday, March 11 for approximately four days



Hours of Work 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Temporary turning restrictions to and from Leopold Place will be in effect during the day. Access to and from Leopold Place will be open at night. Parking restrictions will be in effect 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Local traffic will be directed to Bushby Street while restrictions to and from Leopold Place are in effect. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern change will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Temporary access and parking restrictions on Leopold Place will be in effect. Nearby residents may hear some noise from excavation activities.
