

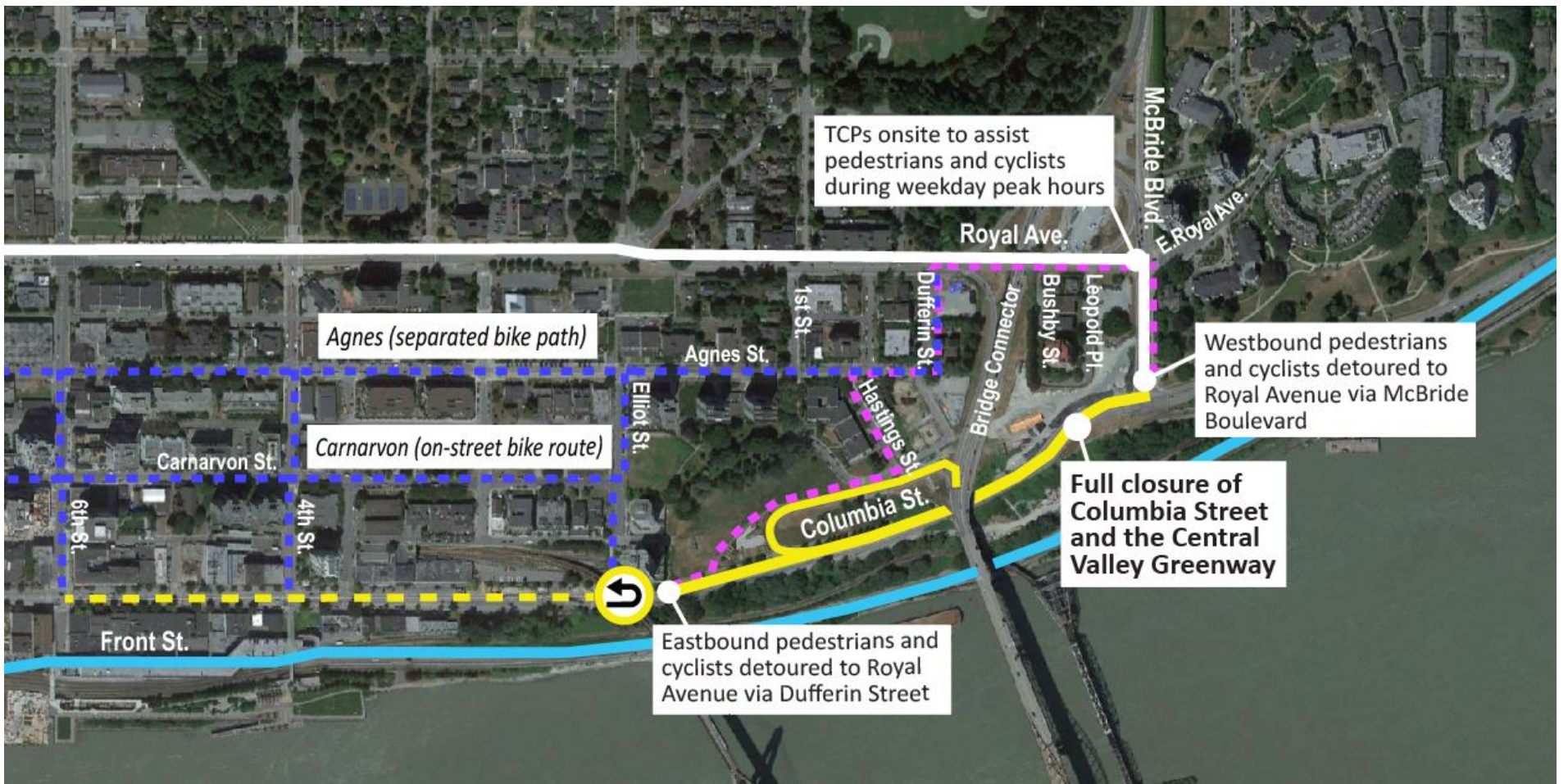
Detour sheet

Regular traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist detour routes during Columbia Street closure

Starting on Tuesday, April 2, Fraser Crossing Partners will implement a one-month full closure of Columbia Street and the Central Valley Greenway between McBride Boulevard and Elliot Street. This full closure is required for crews to lift steel girders across the roadway between the bridge foundations on either side of Columbia Street.

While this closure is in effect, drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists will be detoured to Royal Avenue as shown below. Access to the Pattullo Bridge will be maintained via Bridge Connector and the Royal Avenue on-ramp as the Columbia Street loop-ramp will be closed. Columbia Street between 6th Street and Elliot Street will remain open for local traffic. Access to and from all businesses on Columbia Street and Front Street Mews will be maintained at all times. Businesses are open and all traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed. Commercial vehicles will continue to use Front Street and official truck routes.

All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary.
